The Registry was established in 1999 to improve outcomes for patients having joint replacement surgery.

The Registry collects information directly from patients. This enables a better understanding of how you are feeling, the problems you are having with the joint before your operation and the changes you experience after surgery.

In collecting this data, the Registry aims to further improve the quality and value of healthcare delivery now and in the future.

STUDY INFORMATION

WHAT WILL I NEED TO DO?

All you will need to do is answer a few questions via a secure website before your operation and again at nominate timepoints after your operation. The Registry will contact you via email and/or SMS and occasionally by phone to remind you to complete the questions.

WILL MY DATA BE PROTECTED?

All data will be collected through the secure Registry website. Your personal data is confidential and many measures are in place to protect your information. Only you, and if you give permission, your surgeon can review your results.

HOW TO PARTICIPATE?

You will be registered in the Registry system by your surgeon or hospital. Please use the link in the email or SMS sent by the Registry (AOANJRR) to login and complete your responses.

The Registry would like to thank you for taking the time to consider contributing to the Registry data collection. If you choose to participate you will be able to review your results and see how you compare to other participants via your protected access to the Registry website.

Participating is entirely voluntary and you can decide you no longer want to be involved at any stage. If you decide not to participate this will not impact on the care you receive.
