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INCORRECT PRESENTATION OF DATA

There is a higher proportion of patients undergoing primary partial shoulder replacement that are pre-obese or obese class 1 (62.3%), compared to partial shoulder replacement (55.8%), and revision shoulder replacement (59.8%) (Table S4).

There is a higher proportion of patients undergoing primary total shoulder replacement that are pre-obese or obese class 1 (62.3%), compared to partial shoulder replacement (55.8%), and revision shoulder replacement (59.8%) (Table S4).
